### Admissions

Minimum academic requirement: Bachelor of Sciences Degree.

English language: certified level B2 of the Common European Framework of reference for Language levels.

### Fees

⚡ Non European applicants: 16 000€ for the two-year programme

⚡ European applicants: 8 000€ for the two-year programme

Living expenses estimated at about 700-800€ per month

Transport cost to/from and within Europe

Students are responsible for costs of health & travel insurance: except for Erasmus Mundus beneficiaries.
